ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Dakshina Bharat Hindi Pracharak Training College, P.G. Complex, P.B.No.82, Khairatabad, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh** for **B.Ed. of One year duration** from the academic session **2001-2002** with an annual intake of **60** students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions.

1. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the State Govt. norms.
2. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the State Government/Examining body.
3. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
4. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating examining body.
5. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the State Govt. norms for the Language Teacher Training Course.
6. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per State Govt. norms.
7. The institution shall continue to fulfill the norms laid down under the regulations by the State Govt./Examining body and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of the compliance of the conditions indicated above and should be submitted by the end of each academic year.

If **Dakshina Bharat Hindi Pracharak Training College, P.G. Complex, P.B.No.82, Khairatabad, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh** contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfill the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
