AN INSTITUTION OF NATIONAL IMPORTANCE

Whereas the objects of the Institution known as the Dakshina Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha are such as to make it an institution of National Importance, it is hereby declared that the Dakshina Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha is an Institution of National Importance.

(Section 3 of the Central Act)

POWER OF THE SABHA

“Notwithstanding anything contained in the University Grants Commission Act 1956, or in any other law for the time being in force, the Sabha may hold such examinations and grant such Degrees, Diplomas & Certificates for proficiency in Hindi or in the teaching of Hindi **as may be determined by the Sabha from time to time.**”

(Section 4 of the Central Act)
